**Latin 311**

Cicero is our richest source of classical Latin prose. In this course, students will engage Cicero as orator by reading one of his masterpieces that has been esteemed by students of Latin since ancient times. Particular attention will be given to the skillful use of rhetoric and syntactical figures Cicero employs to fully express his thought and emotions. By acquiring an extended familiarity with Ciceronian style, students will be equipped to better appreciate the writings of Cicero in particular and Latin prose more generally.

Required Texts:

-*Orationes: Volume I: Pro Sex. Roscio, De Imperio Cn. Pompei, Pro Cluentio, In Catilinam, Pro Murena, Pro Caelio.* (Oxford Classical Texts).

-A Latin dictionary is required for this course.
