Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 governs the College's policies and procedures with regard to the privacy of student records. All personally identifiable information in the student's record is confidential except as provided by policy, by law, or where a student has consented in writing to make information available to designated persons or institutions. In keeping with the requirements of FERPA, the following directory information may be released by Magdalen College: the student's name, address, telephone number, major field of study, class, enrollment status, anticipated degree date, religious affiliation, participation in officially recognized activities, and degrees and awards received. Any student who wishes to restrict the release of some or all of the directory information may do so in writing to the Registrar.
